Coming to Humble House was the best decision I ever made in my life. Not only am I gaining an intimate relation with God but I have gained a group of sisters and family in staff to help in my recovery. ### A MESSAGE FROM OUR FOUNDER & CEO

As we wrap up this past year, we want to take a moment to send a heartfelt thank you your way. It has not been the easiest year, but with God’s help and blessings, we have seen so much growth and positive change, and we truly attribute that to your prayers, your time as volunteers, and your generous donations. You are such an important part of this ministry, and we want you to know how much we appreciate you!

We want to honor you by sharing some updates about what we discussed at our 2023 banquet regarding our ministry plans for 2024. We felt God was leading us to expand our current store into a larger space, and guess what? God made that happen! We were able to move the Humble House Thrift Store to 920 W. 26th St. in Lynn Haven, Florida.

We also talked about our vision to sell our Cherry Street home and open a brick-and-mortar facility. This new space would allow us to run a full recovery program on the top floor and provide transitional beds for women and children downstairs. We had quite a bit of renovation work to do first, including creating three family rooms, adding two more recovery beds upstairs, and redesigning the space for staff offices, classroom and living room space for more privacy and protection. With your help, we were able to accomplish all this in 2024! Additionally, we have installed cameras, automatic locking doors, and an ADT security system to ensure the safety of our women and children, especially those who are survivors of sex trafficking. We are so grateful for what God has been able to accomplish this year and we look forward to seeing all that He has planned for 2025, as we plan to pay down our debt on

our current location and begin to save and raise funds to build duplexes for moms and children, whether on a donated property in Panama City or on our current property, however God leads us. Please keep us in your prayers as we seek His guidance for the upcoming year. We wish you and your family all the blessings for the year ahead and in the years to come. Thank you for believing in our mission and the work God has called us to do. We love you all and warmest wishes.
